We will be making our annual trek to the Anderson Farms Pumpkin Patch on Friday September 23rd. Each child will have the opportunity to ride on a wagon to the field and pick out their very own pumpkin to take home. There is also a corn maze, hay bale tower to climb, a large playground and lots of other fun things to explore. Every child is invited to attend—even if your child doesn't normally attend on Fridays.

We will need lots of drivers to help get us to up to the patch (located in Erie) and also help to chaperone while there. We would like to have a 2:1 parent to child ratio, if possible. Also, all children need to have a permission form filled out and returned to us no later than **Friday**September 18th. Please find these and more information in your parent folders.

So that we can leave and arrive on time, we need to have all children at school no later than 8:20 am on that Friday. All children will need to wear sneakers and comfortable clothing as we will be on a farm. Sun hats are also a good idea. We will go rain or shine so please dress your child appropriately. Before we leave, we will place a purple field trip shirt on your child for safety. Children will also need to bring a disposable lunch that does not need to be heated or kept cold.


